



CELEBRATING THE ADVENT SEASON

The Advent Wreath is the traditional centerpiece of the Christmas season. Most often, each wreath holds four candles, lit progressively during Advent. The pink candle is typically first lit during either the third or fourth weeks of Advent, in joyful anticipation of the Nativity. The evergreens symbolize eternal life, and the increasingly brightening light of the candles celebrates our emergence from darkness as Christmas approaches.




